June 9, 2010—With thanks to over 500 Google employees, the INNVISION Georgia Travis Day Center and Commercial Street Inn Night Shelter for homeless families will be transformed, providing much-needed cosmetic upgrades to local centers that provide critical shelter and support services.

INNVISION, Silicon Valley's largest non-profit provider of housing and services to homeless and at-risk families and individuals, is hosting over 500 Google employees at its Georgia Travis Day Center (GTC) and Commercial Street Inn Shelter (CSI) on Wednesday, June 9 from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm. As part of Google's "**All for Good**" program, employees are given the day off to partner with and build upon the efforts of outstanding local non-profits.

Google employees will arrive by the bus load and in seven short hours, they will paint interiors and exteriors (including a mural designed by a talented local artist), lay a new kitchen floor, assist with daily food distribution and provide support for other administrative tasks. Google employees are not only given the day off to do good, Google also donates the cost for ALL relevant materials. InnVision is thrilled to partner with Google for this impactful community service event!

GTC offers emergency assistance for homeless women and children. This multi-service, one-stop center is open weekdays from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm providing meals, healthcare, clothing and counseling. CSI provides 55 shelter beds for women and children, including after school tutorial programs.

"As the Silicon Valley housing and job markets show slow growth and recovery, even more families and individuals will need emergency assistance. InnVision must keep the doors of the Georgia Travis Center and Commercial Street Inn open so that homeless and at-risk residents of our community continue to have a place for short-term shelter and receive much needed services, including job search assistance, email access and an address to receive mail. Without programs like this, many more people will fall through the cracks." said InnVision CEO Christine Burroughs.
